As the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the tri-county (Monterey, San Benito and Santa Cruz) Monterey Bay region, the Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments (AMBAG) performs a wide range of transportation planning activities in the region.

AMBAG is currently seeking a part-time GIS and Planning Intern to work 10-19 hours per week. Candidates (at a minimum) should have already completed at least three year's towards a bachelor's degree in a discipline related to the field of planning or similar (land use/environmental planning/resources/computer science/geography/GIS). Strong and demonstrated use of MS Excel, MS Access, ArcGIS 10.4-10.6 are required. Programming skills for use in ArcGIS are desirable.

Under close supervision, the GIS and Planning Intern assists in the performance of technical and administrative duties related to the functions of the organization and projects assigned. The position provides technical assistance to the planning and GIS department. Intern will respond to GIS data requests, prepare maps, and perform GIS data analysis as required.
