Re: Administrative Modification No. 19 to the Monterey Bay Metropolitan Transportation

Improvement Program (MTIP) FFY 2022-23 to FFY 2025-26

Dear Mr. Le:

Please be advised that AMBAG has approved Administrative Modification No. 19 to the *Monterey Bay MTIP FFY 2022-23 to FFY 2025-26*. This administrative modification makes changes to five (5) projects. Enclosed are the Summary of Changes (Attachment 1) and Project Programming Pages (Attachment 2), as included in Administrative Modification No. 19.

This administrative modification adds \$8,407K funds in the current financial plan for the Monterey Bay MTIP that relies on the State's interim federal programming capacity. Our next MTIP formal amendment will update the financial plan to reflect the actual funding.

Administrative Modification No. 19 to the Monterey Bay MTIP is financially constrained. Also, the Monterey Bay region is designated as attainment for Federal air quality standards, therefore the changes proposed by this administrative modification are not subject to the requirement that an air quality conformity determination be made.

The Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments certifies that the projects included in this Administrative Modification No. 19 are not included in any other MTIP amendment that is currently open for public review.

The projects included in Administrative Modification No. 19 have been developed in accordance with all applicable transportation planning requirements per 23 CFR Part 450 and are expected to support the establishment and achievement of performance management targets.

Under the delegated authority received from Caltrans on February 12, 2020, I approve this

administrative modification to the Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). This revision is consistent with the approved Administrative Modifications/ Amendments Guidelines and Procedures.
