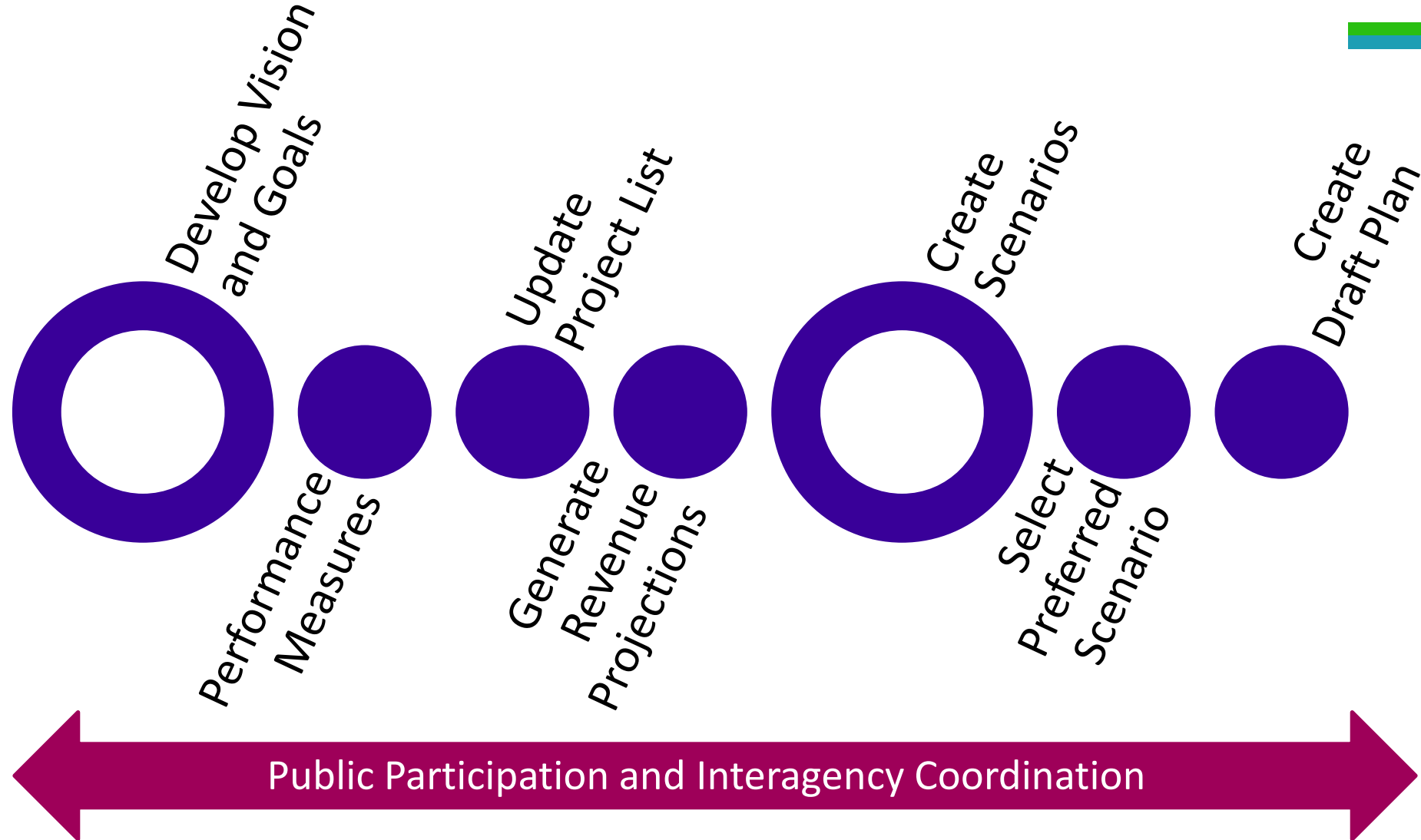


# 2050 MTP/SCS Update

ASSOCIATION OF MONTEREY BAY  
AREA GOVERNMENTS

- Long range plan for transportation investments
- Federal and state law requires that an MTP/SCS be prepared every four years
- Must provide a 20+ year horizon planning period
- Detailed work program and schedule approved in April 2023
- 2050 MTP/SCS scheduled for adoption in June 2026





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- Developed with local and regional partners
- Mix of multimodal and regional/local projects
  - Active transportation
  - Maintenance & rehab
  - Transit
  - Roadway

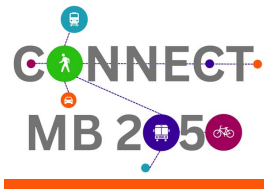


- Land use pattern
  - Population, housing, and employment
- Transportation investments
  - Transit services and rideshare programs
  - Active transportation projects
  - Roadway improvements
  - Other transportation related strategies such as electric vehicles, telecommuting, etc.
- Evaluate using the Regional Travel Demand Model and Board approved performance measures
- Basis for the 2050 MTP/SCS and its EIR

- Programmatic EIR is underway and will serve as the EIR for the 2050 MTP/SCS as well as the EIR for each of the RTPA's county-level Regional Transportation Plan (RTPs)
- AMBAG is the lead for developing the programmatic EIR, working with the RTPAs, an environmental consultants to develop the joint EIR
- The draft EIR is scheduled to be released for public comment in late 2025

- Online survey and public workshops held in spring 2025
  - Input received will be used to develop SCS implementation strategies for the draft 2050 MTP/SCS
- Continue to implement the outreach strategies included in the Board adopted Public Involvement Plan
- Additional workshops/public hearings will be held in early 2026 on the draft 2050 MTP/SCS and EIR

- Continued work on the Draft 2050 MTP/SCS and Draft EIR
- Both documents are scheduled to be released for public review in late 2025
- Public workshops/hearings to be scheduled for January 2026
